SCHOLARSHIP Requirements & Instructions

The Alabama Horse Council Scholarship is awarded to one outstanding youth in Alabama pursuing higher education in a college or university. The Alabama Horse Council Scholarship is awarded to the sons and daughters of AHC members or to an AHC member in good standing. Submit two letters of reference attesting to the applicant's commitment to the equine industry, activity in the industry and character.

- 1) Submit a short (500 word maximum) essay about how horses have shaped your life, and the goals you wish to pursue in the horse industry.
- 2) A list of activities and honors received (high school, civic, church, clubs, etc.).
- 3) Mail 4 copies to the complete application package (cover form, two letters of reference, essay and activity/honor list) to Charlotte Collins, Secretary AHC, P. O. Box 260, Morris, AL 35116 by **December 5, 2010**.

Qualifications

- 1) Applicant or applicant's parent or grandparent must be a current member of the Alabama Horse Council in good standing.
- 2) Applicant must be majoring in a field of study preparing them for a career in the equine industry.
- 3) Applicant must have demonstrated record of activity in the equine industry prior to college application.

Application Requirements

- 1) Complete the one-page cover form.
- 2) Submit two letters of reference attesting to the applicant's commitment to the equine industry, activity in the industry and character.
- 3) Submit a short (500 word maximum) essay about how horses have shaped your life, and goals you wish to pursue in the horse industry.
- 4) Submit a list of activities and honors received (high school, civic, church, clubs, etc.).
- 5) Mail 4 copies of the complete application package (cover form, two letters of reference, essay and activity/honor list) to Charlotte Collins, Secretary AHC, P.O. Box 260, Morris, AL 35116 by **December 5, 2010**.
